CJCC Meeting Minutes

The Criminal Justice Collaborating Council met in Room 240 of the Ozaukee County Justice Center on Monday February 13th from 1:30pm-2:30pm.

Call to Order/Proper Notice/Adoption of Agenda:

Vice-Chair, Adam Gerol called the meeting to order at 1:34pm.

Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Connie Mueller to approve the August 15th and November 15th, 2022, meeting minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Chief Hingiss.

Coordinator Report:

The coalitions have been combined and now we are working on the CHIP objectives.

Financial Report:

\$32,000 left in our funds

We looked at the proposal Ashley Claussen created. It was for a PSA for substance use for Ozaukee County. Budget was attached to the proposal and the amount requested was \$5,805. We voted on the proposal. A motion was made by Liza Drake and Seconded by Adam Gerol and Sheriff Knowles. We approved the proposal and are using the funds for the PSA. It was asked if we spend any other money and we voted last meeting to give Sirona Recovery \$500 for taxi vouchers for their clients to have for medical appointments. We also discussed possibly using money for our Active Case Review team who is currently implementing a survey in the jail to collect data around how to improve our substance use needs for the community.

TAD Program

Julie Meulemans, case manager, has moved onto other job. Melissa Drews is handling all cases until they hire someone.

Total cases of Diversion/DPA & ATR clients: 212

Current Statistics

175 total cases in Diversion/DPA program to date

7 current cases at present

- All current participants are working with Sirona Recovery staff to address their criminogenic risks and needs
- All participants have created a case plan with the staff, based on mutually established goals and priorities

TAD Program Admissions/Discharges: Current Period

- 2 Graduations
- 0 Non-compliance terminations
- 4 Pending potential admissions
- 2 New Admissions

Program Graduations vs. Termination Rates to Date

- 114 total program graduations (67%): successfully completed all program conditions throughout the monitoring period
- 61 total non-compliance terminations (33%): majority of terminations due to positive drug tests

Recidivism Rates of Discharged cases: all present & past programs

205 total program participant discharges – includes both graduations & terminations

Diversion/DPA

- 168 total discharged cases to date
 - 115 successful completions; 61 terminations
- 111 former participants have not committed additional crimes since discharge (64%)
- 65 former participants have committed additional crimes since discharge (36%)
 - **Only 4 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program**

ATR

- 37 total discharged cases to date
 - 17 successful completions; 20 terminations
- 20 former participants have not committed additional crimes since discharge (54%)
- 16 former participants have committed additional crimes since discharge (46%)
 - **Only 5 participants recidivated post-successful discharge from the program**

CJCC Updates:

It's been over 2 years since we voted on Chair and Vice Chair. Adam Gerol was nominated for Chair and Liza Drake and Rachel Alma-Boaz were nominated for vice chair. A vote took place and Majority ruled. Adam Gerol is Chair and Liza Drake is Vice Chair.
